Why this Town Meeting is important

Quietly and without any consultation with Southborough Town Council, Tunbridge Wells Borough Council put forward proposals to remove the two hours free parking in Yew Tree Road car park.

After considerable public opposition, TWBC have now relented and agreed to a public consultation throughout August. A final determination will be made by 1st October 2022.

The proposed loss of the two free hours will have an impact that far outweighs the modest income generated for TWBC. The viability of our new town centre and our already struggling High Street relies on this provision. Access to the medical centre, library, sports pavilion, local businesses child care drop off; they all depend on the two hours free parking.

Some ten years ago the previous administration introduced charges in the car park, resulting in parked cars in the surrounding roads and impeding the access of emergency vehicles. We suffered congestion on the roads and an empty car park before they accepted the first two hours should be free.

As two local town councillors we have called this meeting so that residents have the chance to be fully informed on this important issue.

You will also have the opportunity to comment, discuss and ask questions of the TWBC Cabinet members proposing these charges.
